Judy Chase is the Executive Director of Court Services who oversees County Court Services and Drug Court programs. Ms. Chase has graduate and under-graduate degrees from Central Missouri State University, having receiving a Master's degree in Sociology with an emphasis on Corrections. In addition, Ms. Chase attended classes at Wright State University in Dayton, Ohio, and has extended training in the fields of addiction and corrections. Ms. Chase was employed with Missouri Probation and Parole in excess of 22 years, with her last position as District Administrator of 4-West in Kansas City. After leaving Probation and Parole, Ms. Chase took a position as Director of a residential corrections facility in Kansas City, and then purchased County Court Services, Inc. As president of CCS, Ms. Chase obtained and managed contracts with Jackson County to provide Drug Court treatment, the Kansas City Police Department to provide methamphetamine specific treatment, the Department of Corrections to provide case management at the TREND program, and with the Division of Family Services to provide a program for welfare to working parents. Ms. Chase was also co-owner and director of a residential facility for those individuals with chronic and serious mental illness. Ms. Chase is past Chairman of the Board of Directors of the City Chemical Abuse Council, and is a former board member of Renaissance West Treatment Agency and the Citizens Advisory Board. Ms. Chase has also served as a volunteer with Probation and Parole and the Good Samaritan Project.
